

## On-site Nuclear Power Seminar in Prague, Czech Republic

JICC co-hosted a local seminar with the Czech Ministry of Industry and Trade (MoIT) on September 29, 2025, in a conference room at the MoIT in Prague, Czech Republic.

### <Background/Objectives>

Held an on-site seminar in Prague at the request of the Czech Ministry of Industry and Trade (MoIT) as an international cooperation project to establish infrastructure for nuclear power generation in the Czech Republic.

### <Details>

Approximately 40 experts from both countries participated in the seminar. Presentations on “Emergency Preparedness and Response” from various perspectives were given by key figures from the Czech Nuclear Regulatory Authority (SUJB), the Czech State Power Company (CEZ), the Czech Nuclear Research Institute (CVR), the Czech Technical University (CTU), and the Czech Fire and Rescue Service, at the invitation of the Czech Ministry of Industry and Trade (MoIT). Presentations from the Japanese side included speakers from the Agency for Natural Resources and Energy (METI), Fukui Prefectural Government, a home to several nuclear power plants, and JICC, all addressing the same theme. Following the presentations by experts from both countries, a constructive exchange of views took place.

### <Results>

His Excellency Mr. Nagaoka, Japan’s Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to the Czech Republic, delivered the opening remarks. Through presentations on “Emergency Preparedness and Response” by experts from both the Czech Republic and Japan, along with meaningful information exchange, the seminar contributed to maintaining the positive relationship between the two countries in the field of nuclear power generation.
